

## CHAPTER 62.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 102]

To amend Section 589 of Chapter IV of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Sec. 1. That Section 589 of Chapter IV of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 589. BOUNTY ON HAIR SEAL. There is hereby placed upon every hair seal inhabiting the inland waters and all waters adjacent to the Southern Coast of Alaska and East of the 152nd. Meridian, and the waters of Bering Sea, and Golovin Bay lying within a line drawn from the tip of Rocky Point to the tip of Cape Darby, a bounty of Two (\$2.00) Dollars, such sum to be paid in accordance with the provisions following.”

## CHAPTER 63.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 67]

Providing for the relief of unemployment, and appropriating Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) for the construction and repair of rural schools, fuel sheds for rural schools, and for the purchase and installation of equipment in rural schools in the Territory of Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That in order to provide for the relief of unemployment in the Territory of Alaska there is

hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00), or as much thereof as may be necessary, for the construction and repair of rural schools and fuel sheds for rural schools, and for the purchase and installation of equipment for rural schools in the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. The Territorial Board of Education is hereby empowered to expend not to exceed the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) appropriated upon the erection and equipping of such rural schools in the Territory of Alaska as in its judgement are deemed necessary, to be paid out on vouchers approved by the President of the Territorial Board of Education. <sup>is \$40,000 to be expended on rural schools.</sup>

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval. <sup>Emergency.</sup>

## CHAPTER 64.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 96]

To establish scholarships for certain high school graduates in the Territory to attend the University of Alaska.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the high school student in each graduating class in the several high schools of the Territory, who, upon the completion of four years of high school work in the high schools of the Territory, obtains the highest average standing for all the credits earned, and who is graduated at an annual commence- <sup>Scholarships.</sup>
