

CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT

[H. B. 17]

To appropriate Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00) for the purpose of rehabilitating and maintaining the old abandoned U. S. Signal Corps telegraph lines between Eureka Creek and Rampart and between Tanana and Unalakleet; these telegraph lines to be used as public telephone lines, and authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners to have charge and supervision over both the work involved and any and all sums of money expended under this appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00) is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to be expended by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, for the purpose of rehabilitating and maintaining the old abandoned U. S. Signal Corps telegraph lines between Eureka Creek and Rampart and between Tanana and Unalakleet for the biennium beginning July 1, 1935 and ending June 30, 1937; and authorizing said Board to make such expenditures under this appropriation as may be required. Provided that the monies allotted under this Act may not be expended except that after an investigation to determine the feasibility of the rehabilitation of the said telegraph lines and the advisability of their maintenance as a factor in the development or service of the districts affected, the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners shall approve the project.

Section 2. Payments under this Act shall be made by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT

[H. B. 66]

To provide for the acceptance of an Act of Congress approved February 23, 1917, and any other Act or Acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto; to accept the benefits of all of the respective funds therein made available; to designate the Territorial Treasurer as custodian of all moneys allotted to the Territory of Alaska under said Act or Acts; to designate the Territorial Board of Education to cooperate with the Federal Board of Vocational Education; to provide funds for the administration of said Acts or Acts, and for other purposes; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Territory of Alaska hereby accepts, together with the benefits of all respective funds appropriated thereunder, all of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved February 23, 1917, Public 347, Sixty-fourth Congress, entitled: "An Act to provide for the promotion of vocational education; to provide for cooperation with the States in the promotion of such education in agriculture, home economics and trades and industries; to provide for the cooperation of the States in the preparation of teachers of vocational subjects; and to appropriate money and regulate its expenditures," and any Act or Acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto.
