

## CHAPTER 82.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 141]

To amend Chapter 27, Compiled Laws of Alaska 1933, providing for the installation of radio telephones, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Chapter 27, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto another section, to be numbered 1745, to read as follows:

“Sec. 1745. The Board of Administration upon rec-<sup>Radio telephone.</sup>ommendation of the Highway Engineer, on behalf of the Territory shall have authority to enter into contracts for a period not exceeding two years, with persons, firms or corporations now maintaining radio stations for the use thereof of such stations by the Territory under such reasonable rules and regulations and for such compensation as the Board of Administration may approve.”

Section 2. An ~~e~~mergency is hereby declared to exist,<sup>Emergency.</sup> and this Act shall be in force and effect immediately after its passage and approval.
