

On what condition reinstated.

"Sec. 1021. Conditions for reinstatement; Added penalty. Whenever any corporation shall have had its name stricken, it shall, in applying for reinstatement, pay all annual corporation taxes and penalties then due, and an additional penalty of ten dollars for each year it has so failed to pay its annual corporation tax, up to the time of the application for reinstatement, including the two years prior to the date of its being stricken; and upon such payment it shall be the duty of the Auditor to enter upon his records a notation that such corporation is reinstated.

CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT

[H. B. 98]

To appropriate funds for expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the biennium beginning April 1, 1935 and ending March 31, 1937, and for the school years commencing July 1, 1935 and ending June 30, 1936 and commencing July 1, 1936 and ending June 30, 1937, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation for bienniums ending March 31, 1936 and March 31, 1937.

Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the Territory for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1935 and ending March 31, 1936, and for the fiscal year commencing April 1, 1936, and ending March 31, 1937, said sums to be apportioned according to the following schedules.
