

House Concurrent Resolutions

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

WHEREAS, the Governor of Alaska has submitted to the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska the names of three trustees for the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines and the names of two persons to be the Board of Education of the Territory of Alaska.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska, and the Senate concurring that a joint session of the Alaska Territorial Legislature be held on January Twenty-sixth, 1935, at 11:30 A.M. in the Chamber of the House for the purpose of considering the appointments aforementioned and confirming or rejecting the same.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3.

A BILL

WHEREAS, copies of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1933, were furnished to each member of the Twelfth Session of the Alaska Legislature for the use of the members in consideration of legislation before them; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the said members to take the said Compiled Laws to their respective homes at the end of the session;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That each member of the twelfth session of the Alaska Legislature be permitted to take the volume used by him during the present session, with him.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4.

WHEREAS the Governor of Alaska has submitted to the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska a name for Commissioner of Mines as provided for under House Bill No. 57.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, the Senate concurring, that a joint session of the Legislature be held on March 14, 1935, in the Chambers of the House of Representatives, for the purpose of considering the said appointment and confirming or rejecting the same.
