

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That a committee composed of the Attorney General, the Auditor and the Highway Engineer make inquiry into all general matters of administration of the Territory's business and make a report of same with recommendations to the next Legislature, for its information in considering the possible extension of the functions of the said Board of Administration.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 14.

That the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate be, and they hereby are, authorized to expend the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) each, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for payment of additional clerical help of the Twelfth Session.

The Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the above mentioned sum upon warrants issued by the Auditor in accordance with law, said warrants to be issued upon vouchers approved by the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate acting for their respective Houses.
