

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, being truly appreciative of the interest manifested and the aid rendered by His Excellency, Franklin D. Roosevelt, President of the United States of America; and,

Since January 30 is the birthday of the President, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House be and hereby are instructed to express by telegram to his Excellency, Franklin D. Roosevelt, President of the United States of America, congratulations upon his birthday and the well wishes of the Legislature and the entire people of the Territory of Alaska.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 8.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the Governor of Alaska be, and he hereby is, authorized to employ, for such number of hours per day and for such compensation as shall to him seem necessary and reasonable, a janitor and char woman to clean, care for and keep in proper order the rooms occupied by the Legislature; and that the expenses necessarily incurred therefor, not in any event to exceed Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00), shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska, upon vouchers signed by the Governor, or otherwise as may be provided by law.
