SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2.

WHEREAS, by Act of Congress approved March 26, 1934, the date of the biennial elections for a Delegate to Congress and the election of the members of the Territorial Legislature is changed from the time fixed therefor in the Organic Act of this Territory; and

WHEREAS, it is important that information of such change be as widely distributed as possible;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Senate, the House concurring, that when the laws passed at the present session of the Legislature are permanently bound there shall be inserted therein, immediately following the Organic Act, the Act of Congress (H.R. 6785) approved March 26, 1934, expressly "An Act fixing the date for holding elections of a Delegate from Alaska, to the House of Representatives and of members of the Legislature of Alaska, fixing the date on which the Legislature of Alaska shall meet and prescribing the personnel of the Territorial Canvassing Board, defining its duties and for other purposes."
