

# LAWS OF ALASKA

## CHAPTER 1.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 31]

To amend subsection 3 of Section 5, Chapter 78, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Amended.

Section 1. Subsection 3 of Section 5, Chapter 78, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Intoxicating liquor license may be reissued for sale of liquor within 200 feet of school or church, when.

(3) No license shall be issued for the sale of any intoxicating liquor in any building within two hundred feet of any school building or church. Provided, however, that a license may be reissued for the sale of intoxicating liquor in any building in which the sale of intoxicating liquor was at the time of the passing of this Act, authorized by law.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
