

CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT

[S. B. 26]

To amend Section 5598 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to appeals from Justice's Courts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

Section 1. That Section 5598 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended to read as follows:

Appeals from
Justice Courts.

“Section 5598. **Transcript, when filed and what constitutes.** Within twenty days after the allowance of the appeal the appellant must file with the clerk of the District Court a transcript of the cause. The transcript must contain a copy of all the material entries in the justice's docket relating to the cause or the appeal, and must have annexed thereto all the original papers relating to the cause or the appeal and filed with the justice.” Provided, however, that the Court may allow the filing of such transcript after the time herein limited and within sixty days from the allowance of the appeal, if it appears that the delay was not due to negligence upon the part of appellant.

CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT

[H. B. 85]

To appropriate the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars to assist in the relief and rehabilitation of the City of Douglas, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Relief and
rehabilitation
of City of
Douglas, Alaska.

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the funds

in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, to assist in the relief and rehabilitation of the City of Douglas, Alaska, which recently suffered the loss of its entire business section and a great part of its residential section by fire.

Section 2. This appropriation shall be paid out by the City Council of Douglas on vouchers approved by the Governor of Alaska. How paid.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 13.

AN ACT

[S. B. 17]

To amend Section 1459 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to the filing of independent candidates.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1459 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: "Sec. 1459. Party designation on ballot; independent candidates. The names of all candidates who have been duly and legally nominated or selected by a political party in conformity with law shall be placed upon the official ballot under the proper grouping and each followed by the name of the political party by whom he has been nominated or selected. Amended.
Party designation on Ballots
—Placing of Names.

The names of candidates not representing any political party shall be placed on the official ballot followed Independent Candidate for Territorial Office—Application, where filed.
