

CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT

[H. B. 48]

To amend Section 1311 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to the establishment of school districts in the Territory of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

Section 1. That Section 1311 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

School Districts
Incorporated.

Sec. 1311. School Districts Outside Incorporated Towns. Any town, village or settlement in this Territory outside the limits of any incorporated town, having a population of one hundred or more, and thirty children between the ages of six and seventeen years, may incorporate as a school district in the manner hereinafter provided, but such school district shall not embrace more than forty square miles of territory. Provided, however, that where such district contains more than thirty children between the ages of six and seventeen years, the school district may embrace one hundred fifty square miles.
