CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT

[H. B. 40]

To accept the benefits of the provisions of an Act of Congress approved June 20, 1936, and entitled "An Act to extend the benefits of the Adams Act, the Purnell Act, and the Capper-Ketcham Act to the Territory of Alaska, and for other purposes," and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The grants of money authorized by Acts of Congress entitled: "An Act to provide for an in-

creased annual appropriation for agricultural experiment stations and regulating the expenditure thereof", approved March 16, 1906, and known as the Adams Act, "An Act to authorize the more complete endowment of agricultural experiment stations, and for other purposes", approved February 24, 1925, and known as the Purnell Act, and "An Act to provide for the further development of agricultural extension work between the agricultural colleges in the several states receiving the benefits of the Act entitled 'An Act donating public lands to the several states and territories which may provide colleges for the benefit of agriculture and the mechanic arts,' approved July 2, 1862, and all Acts supplementary thereto, and the United States Department of Agriculture", approved May 22, 1928, and known as the Capper-Ketcham Act, having been made available for the Territory of Alaska as extended to the Territory of Alaska by an Act of Congress entitled "An Act to extend the benefits of the Adams Act, the Purnell Act, and the Capper-Ketcham Act to the Territory of Alaska, and for other purposes", approved June 20, 1936, being made subject to the legislative assent of the several states and territories to the purpose of said grants, the assent of the Territory of Alaska is hereby given to the purpose of said grants, and the conditions of the above specified Acts of Congress are hereby accepted by the Territory of Alaska.

In accordance with the provisions of the Capper-Ketcham Act, as extended to the Territory of Alaska, the University of Alaska is hereby designated as the beneficiary under the provisions of said Act and the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska is hereby designated as the officer to whom grants of money under said Act shall be paid.

CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT

[H. B. 83]

To appropriate the sum of \$1189.00 to pay J. B. Burford & Company for merchandise purchased by the Territory of Alaska from said Company, and to appropriate an extra sum of \$75.00 for boxing, storage, insurance and returning equipment, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territory of Alaska, the sum of Eleven Hundred Eighty-nine Dollars, to pay J. B. Burford & Company for the following items of merchandise purchased by the Territory of Alaska from said Company for use of the Territorial Legislature, Thirteenth Session: Two A. B. Dick Mimeographs, Models No. 77-A-85, Serial Nos. 72513 and 72514, with Paper Feeds, Serial Nos. 28214 and 28213, \$279.00; Thirteen L. C. Smith Typewriters, Serial Nos. 1257804B, 1262105B, 1269342B, 1269329B, 1261850B, 1269534B, 1262129B, 1262065B, 1268551B, 1261972B, 1261936B, 1251665 B, and 1251667B, \$910.00.
