

Section 4. In accordance with the provisions of the Capper-Ketcham Act, as extended to the Territory of Alaska, the University of Alaska is hereby designated as the beneficiary under the provisions of said Act and the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska is hereby designated as the officer to whom grants of money under said Act shall be paid.

Beneficiary of benefits of Capper-Ketcham act designated as University of Alaska.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT

[H. B. 83]

To appropriate the sum of \$1189.00 to pay J. B. Burford & Company for merchandise purchased by the Territory of Alaska from said Company, and to appropriate an extra sum of \$75.00 for boxing, storage, insurance and returning equipment, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territory of Alaska, the sum of Eleven Hundred Eighty-nine Dollars, to pay J. B. Burford & Company for the following items of merchandise purchased by the Territory of Alaska from said Company for use of the Territorial Legislature, Thirteenth Session: Two A. B. Dick Mimeographs, Models No. 77-A-85, Serial Nos. 72513 and 72514, with Paper Feeds, Serial Nos. 28214 and 28213, \$279.00; Thirteen L. C. Smith Typewriters, Serial Nos. 1257804B, 1262105B, 1269342B, 1269329B, 1261850B, 1269534B, 1262129B, 1262065B, 1268551B, 1261972B, 1261936B, 1251665 B, and 1251667B, \$910.00.

\$1,189.00 appropriated to pay J. B. Burford & Company for merchandise purchased for use of Thirteenth Session of Territorial Legislature.

\$75.00 appropriated for carrying for equipment until next legislative session.

Section 2. There is also hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territory not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Seventy-five Dollars to pay the above said Company for boxing, storage, insurance, repairing and returning said equipment two days prior to the convening of the next session of the Territorial Legislature.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT

[H. B. 19]

To reimburse the Associated Salmon Packers, Inc., for moneys erroneously paid by it, in connection with filing its Articles of Incorporation, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation reimbursing Associated Salmon Packers, Inc., for money erroneously paid.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the moneys in the treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of One Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$135.00) to be paid to the Associated Salmon Packers, Inc., as a refund of the fees erroneously paid by this Company in connection with filing its Articles of Incorporation, which said sum was deposited in the treasury of the Territory of Alaska.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
