

“Sec. 1794. Reimbursement for services rendered indigents. The Governor shall have power to reimburse hospitals and physicians for expenses incurred and services rendered for relief, of indigents who have no relatives within the Territory liable for this support. No charge for expense incurred under the provisions of this section shall be in excess of the expenses actually and necessarily incurred, and the following schedule of fees shall be the maximum paid by the Territory:

Governor authorized reimburse hospitals and physicians for care of indigents.

Maximum fees allowable.

- Medical attendance \$1.00 per visit.
- Minor operations \$5.00.
- Major operations \$50.00.
- Digital amputation \$10.00.

Provided: That this does not apply to the schedule of fees charged by orthopedic surgeons in the treatment of crippled children coming under the supervision of the Commissioner of Health. Here the schedule of fees shall be based on the going rates in the State of Washington as used by the Department of Labor and Industry, Medical Division of Industrial Insurance.”

CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT

[H. B. 68]

To appropriate \$20,000 for the construction of buildings for rural schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$20,000.00, or as much thereof

Appropriation for construction of rural school buildings and installation of equipment in same.

Proviso.

as may be necessary, for the construction of school buildings for rural schools and for the installation and equipment of the same in the Territory of Alaska during the 1937-1939 biennium; provided that no part of said funds shall be expended except under the direction of the Commissioner of Education and the President of the Board of Education, with the approval of all members of the Board of Education.

Upon what terms paid and by whom.

Section 2. The Territorial Board of Education is hereby empowered to expend not to exceed the sum of \$20,000.00 appropriated by this Act for the erection of rural school buildings in the Territory of Alaska during the 1937-1939 biennium, if in its judgment the same are deemed necessary, or if in its judgment the expenditure of the same, or any part thereof, will result in a decrease in the total cost of the support of schools in the Territory of Alaska; and the funds hereby appropriated, if expended shall be paid out on vouchers approved by the Commissioner of Education and the President of the Territorial Board of Education.

CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT

[H. B. 74]

To appropriate Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the use and aid of the Alaska Territorial Chamber of Commerce during the biennium commencing April 1, 1937, and authorizing the payment thereof by warrants drawn upon the Territorial Treasurer, and providing for the reporting by said Chamber of its activities and disbursements, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation for Territorial Chamber of Commerce.

Section 1. That the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of monies in the
