Section 3. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to said Alaska Territorial Chamber of Commerce the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) upon warrants drawn hereunder.

Section 4. The Alaska Territorial Chamber of Commerce, prior to the convening of the 1939 session of the Alaska Territorial Legislature, shall make to the Governor a written, verified report of its activities and of its activities and of its disbursements not only of all Territorial funds paid to it under this Act, but also of all funds otherwise received or collected by it.

Emergency.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT

[H. B. 80]

To appropriate the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) for construction and equipping a hospital at Kodiak, Alaska, for the benefit of the residents thereof, and vicinity, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for assistance
in construction
and equipping
of hospital at
Kodiak, Alaska.

Section 1. That the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby appropriated, out of the funds of the Territory of Alaska, to assist in the construction and equipment of a hospital at Kodiak, Alaska.

Section 2. That the appropriation hereby made, shall become available upon the construction of such a hospital, and the said appropriation shall be utilized for equipping and maintaining the same during the Biennium ending March 31, 1939.

Appropriation available—when and for what purpose.

Section 3. That the management and control of the said hospital shall be in the hands of a Board of Trustees, appointed by the Governor of Alaska, and residing at Kodiak, and the said management shall be supervised by the Commissioner of Health of the Territory of Alaska.

Managed by Board of Trustees and supervised by Commissioner of Health.

Section 4. That vouchers covering expenditures under the provisions of this Act, shall be approved by the said Board of Trustees and the Commissioner of Health, and submitted to the Auditor of Alaska, for settlement and payment.

All vouchers to be approved by Trustees and commissioner of health.

Section 5. That the appropriation, provided for herein, shall not become effective or available until the town of Kodiak, Alaska shall be duly incorporated as a city of the second class, or as an independent school district, and/or public utility district.

Restrictions.

Section 6. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
