

## CHAPTER 41.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 64]

To correct, by amendment, Section 1353, Article VIII, Chapter XVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, to conform to the provisions of Section 73, Chapter 97, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, relating to duties of school officers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Act amending

Section 1. That Section 1353, Article VIII, Chapter XVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to conform to the provisions of Section 73, Chapter 97, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, to read as follows:

Duties of  
School Officers.

Section 1353. Duties of School Officers. It shall be the duty of the superintendent, principal or teacher of each public or private school to report all violations of this Article to the school board in the school district in which such school is situated and such school board shall, on receiving such report or on the complaint of any person, make full and impartial investigation of all charges for violation of any of the provisions of this Article. If it shall appear upon such investigation, that any parent, guardian, or other person has violated any of the provisions of this Article, it is hereby made the duty of such school board to make and file with the United States Commissioner in whose precinct such school is situated, a complaint against such parent, guardian, or other person, charging such violation, and the said United States Commissioner thereupon shall issue a warrant for the arrest of the said parent, guardian, or other person, and shall have the power and jurisdiction to act upon the complaint of the school board, and take such action or impose such fine, under

this Article, as the circumstances justify. Reports of violation of this Article rendered to school boards by the superintendent, principal, or teacher shall be made in writing and it shall be made the duty of such superintendent, principal or teacher to forward to the Commissioner of Education a duplicate copy of each report. Blank forms for such report shall be provided by the Commissioner of Education.

## CHAPTER 42.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 34]

To amend the Seventh Sub-section of Section 5336, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to the conduct of trials.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Seventh Sub-section of Section 5336, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended to read as follows:

Amendment.

Seventh. The court, when the evidence is concluded and before or after the argument of counsel, shall immediately, and before proceeding with other business, charge the jury; which charge, shall be reduced to writing by the court, and a copy of such instructions shall be given to the counsel for each of the parties plaintiff and defendant; such charge or charges, or any other charge or instructions provided for in this section, when so written and given, shall in no case be orally qualified, modified or in any other manner explained to the jury by the court; and all written
