

## CHAPTER 50.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 52]

To provide for the construction of a landing field for airplanes at the Town of Candle, Alaska, and appropriating the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) therefor.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or so much as may be necessary is hereby appropriated and made available and payable out of the Road Funds appropriated and allowed to the Second Division of the Territory of Alaska for the biennium ending March 31, 1939, for the purpose of building and constructing a landing field for airplanes at or near the Town of Candle, Alaska, at such point as shall be designated by the Territorial Highway Engineer.

Section 2. That the said landing field shall be constructed under the supervision of the Highway Engineer, and the moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants approved by the Highway Engineer specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn.
