

CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT

[H. B. 53]

To appropriate the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to assist the town of Douglas, Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to assist the town of Nenana and Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) to assist the town of Eagle, in the construction and/or repair of their school houses, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation to assist Douglas, Alaska, in construction new school building, and for repair of school buildings in Nenana, and Eagle, Alaska.

Section 1. That the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the Treasury of the Territory not otherwise appropriated to assist the town of Douglas in the construction of a new school building; that the sums of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for Nenana and Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for Eagle are hereby appropriated. Said sums shall be expended for the construction and/or repair of the school buildings in the above named towns in the manner hereinafter provided.

How expended.

Section 2. The said sums shall be expended under the supervision of the Common Council of said towns and shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Commissioner of Education.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
