

## CHAPTER 66.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 55]

Making an appropriation for the University of Alaska to construct and equip a power plant and a women's dormitory, and for other purposes, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Appropriation for buildings and equipment on Campus of University of Alaska.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory, from funds not otherwise appropriated, the sum of One Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$195,000.00) to the University of Alaska, to be expended by said corporation in constructing and equipping necessary buildings on the campus of the said University.

Specified sum used for power plant, etc.

Section 2. That of the sum hereby appropriated, One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be available for constructing a power plant of reinforced concrete, equipping the same with suitable boilers, stokers, pumps, generators, and accessory machinery, a reservoir or reservoirs, and constructing and equipping the necessary conduits for the purpose of providing heat, water, light, power and sewage disposal for the use of the University of Alaska.

Specified sum used for Dormitory for women.

Section 3. That of the sum hereby appropriated, Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) shall be available for constructing and equipping a reinforced concrete fireproof building as a dormitory for women.

Funds appropriated may be expended in cooperation with Federal Government.

Section 4. That the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska is also hereby authorized to expend part or all of the funds hereby appropriated in cooperation with any department or division of the Fed-

eral Government, now existing or later to be established, for the purpose of assisting public institutions in the several states and territories in their respective construction projects, and, to the extent that other or additional funds are provided, to extend the building and construction program specified in Sections 2 and 3 herein.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

## CHAPTER 67.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 81]

To limit expenses of officials and employees traveling for the Territory of Alaska.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Officials and employees of the Territory of Alaska, and all institutions operating in connection therewith, shall be guided by the following instructions when traveling on official business for the Territory. Territorial

#### TERRITORIAL TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

1. **Written Authority.** Officials and employees traveling on Territorial business, shall have written authority for the said travel, issued by the head of the office chargeable for the same, provided however that in cases of emergency, the authority can subsequently be supplied. Written author-
