## CHAPTER 68.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 27]

To appropriate Six Thousand Four Hundred and Thirteen Dollars and Twenty-five Cents (\$6,413.25) to pay claims against the Territory of Alaska for hospitalization, medical services and for other purposes, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Appropriation  
to pay claims  
for hospitali-  
zation, etc.

Section 1. That the sum of Six Thousand Four Hundred and Thirteen Dollars and Twenty-five Cents (\$6,413.25) is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated to cover claims submitted against the Territory as follows:

Payment for services under this appropriation shall be made only upon vouchers properly itemized, and approved by the Governor of Alaska, and no such voucher shall include any claim for expense incurred subsequent to February 5, 1937.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist Emergency. and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 69.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 53]

To appropriate the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) to pay the claim of the Maynard Columbus Hospital at Nome, Alaska, for hospitalization and medical services rendered to A. S. Kemp and Joe Erle, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to cover the claims submitted against the Territory by the Maynard Columbus Hospital at Nome, Alaska, for the hospitalization and medical care of A. S. Kemp in the sum of One Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$135.00), and Joe Erle in the sum of Sixty-five Dollars (\$65.00), and in the total sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Appropriation to pay claims of hospitalization, etc.

Payment for services under this appropriation shall be made only upon vouchers properly itemized and approved by the Governor of Alaska.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, Emergency. and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
