

CHAPTER 7.

AN ACT

[H. B. 24]

To appropriate funds for payment of deficiencies in various appropriations heretofore made, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Deficiency appropriations for biennium ending June 30, 1937.

Section 1. The following sums of money are hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory, or as much thereof as shall in each case be necessary, for the purposes stated below, which appropriations are to be supplementary to the appropriations heretofore made for the same purposes:

Support of city schools.

(a) Forty-three Thousand One Hundred Fifty-two Dollars and Sixty-five Cents for the payment of the support of city schools for the biennium ending June 30, 1937.

Transportation of pupils.

(b) Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars for the payment of transportation of pupils for the biennium ending June 30, 1937.

Tuition.

(c) Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars for the payment of tuition for the biennium ending June 30, 1937.

Department of Health.

(d) Three Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-one Dollars and Forty-nine Cents for the payment of contingent expenses of the Territorial Department of Health for the biennium ending March 31, 1937.

Rescue and relief lost persons.

(e) Five Hundred Eighty-one Dollars and Eighty-nine Cents for the payment of Rescue and Relief of Lost Persons during the biennium ending March 31, 1937.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist Emergency. and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT

[H. B. 301

To provide for the care and custody of real property owned by the Territory.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That it shall be the duty of the Board of Administration to have the care and custody of all property of the Territory of Alaska, except that, at present, under the care of the officers of the University of Alaska, the Commissioner of Education, and the Board of Trustees of the Pioneers' Home, to keep the records of the same, and to see that the same is protected by sufficient insurance; and to repair and improve the same as necessary. Care and custody of Territorial property.

Section 2. That the cost of all minor repairs of such property shall be paid out of the emergency appropriation, upon vouchers approved by the Board of Administration. Cost of repairs paid out of emergency appropriation.
