CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT

[S. B. 72]

To amend Section 3135, Article III, Chapter LXI, Section 3169, Article VI, Chapter LXI and Section 2703, Chapter XLVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to licenses, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

Section 1. That Section 3135, Article III, Chapter LXI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

Accounting by school tax collector.

Section 3135. **Accounting by Collector.** The school tax collector shall keep an accurate account of all moneys collected by him and shall, on the first day of each month during the period within which the tax herein is provided for is due and payable, transmit all such moneys in his hands, less commissions as provided for in Section 3136, Article III, Chapter LXI, to the Treasurer of the Territory with a list of persons from whom collected. Such statement shall be verified by the affidavit of the school tax collector to the effect that the same is in all respects a full and true statement of all moneys received by him.

Supplemental accounting.

After the first Monday in the month of August in each year, the school tax collector shall, at least once

in three months, file an additional statement setting forth any taxes and penalties collected by him during said period of three months, and shall transmit said moneys to the Treasurer. Such supplemental statement shall be made and verified as herein provided for the first statement.

Section 2. That Section 3169, Article VI, Chapter LXI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows: Amended.

Section 3169. **Agents license; Treasurer not liable for defalcations.** The Treasurer is hereby authorized to appoint the United States Commissioners of the several precincts or any other persons as his agents to take applications, issue the licenses and collect the license fees herein provided. The said commissioners or other agents of the Treasurer who are not otherwise employed on salary or wages from the Territory, shall receive for their services, twenty-five cents (25c) for each resident fisherman's license so issued, and a fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for each non-resident fisherman's license so issued. The Commissioners or other agents shall monthly transmit to the Treasurer all fees collected by them, less the commissions as above provided, together with a full account of the same. Agents license—

Fee for agent

The Treasurer shall not be liable for the defalcation or failure to account for the fees so collected by any Commissioner or other agent so appointed, but it hereby empowered to require a bond in such sum as he may deem proper conditioned upon the faithful accounting of all moneys collected by said commissioners or other agents. Section 3. That Section 2703, Chapter XLVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows: Amended.

Section 2703. **Territorial moneys covered into Territorial Treasury.** Every office, board, commission or bureau authorized to collect or receive any fees, licenses, taxes or other money, and every office, commission or bureau of the United States, or other authorized agency, authorized to collect any fees, licenses, taxes or other money belonging to this Territory, shall account for and pay such fees, licenses, taxes or other money, less any fees he may be entitled to under existing law, to the Territorial Treasurer at least once each month and the same be covered into the general fund.

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT

[S. B. 24]

To amend Sections 1531, 1532, and 1533, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to absentee voting.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

That Sections 1531, 1532, and 1533, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended to read as follows:

tor may vote at
general elec-
tion, if—

Section 1531. **Absentee Voting Authorized.** Any elector of the Territory who believes that he will be unavoidably absent from his home, and more than 2 miles distant from the voting place in which he is qualified to vote, may vote at any general election in the manner provided for in this Article.
