CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT

[S. B. 29]

To repeal Chapter XVI, Sections 1 and 2 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, relative to requiring advance notice of alibi defense and time of commission of offense in criminal prosecutions, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Chapter XVI, Sections 1 and 2 of ^{Repeal.} the Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist ^{Emergency.} and this Act shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
