

CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT

[H. B. 72]

To appropriate funds for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska, for the biennium beginning April 1, 1937, and ending March 31, 1939, and for the school years commencing July 1, 1937, and ending June 30, 1938, and commencing July 1, 1938, and ending June 30, 1939, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriations
for Biennium
ending March
31, 1939.

Section 1. The sum of Two Million, Six Hundred Thirty Four Thousand, Nine Hundred Thirty Dollars or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the Territory for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1937, and ending March 31, 1938, and for the fiscal year commencing April 1, 1938, and ending March 31, 1939, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:
