## CHAPTER 9.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 111]

Transferring the sum of Four Hundred and Three Thousand Dollars (\$403,000.00) to the Old-Age Assistance Fund; to appropriate the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) for the support of persons for Old-Age Assistance, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Treasurer of this Territory be, and he is hereby, directed to cover into the Old-Age Assistance Fund the sum of Four Hundred and Three Thousand Dollars (\$403,000.00) heretofore appropriated for an allowance to aged residents of Alaska pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 82, Session Laws of 1937.

Section 2. That there be, and there is hereby, appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of this Territory the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to carry out the provisions of

that certain Act entitled "An Act relating to and providing for old-age assistance, accepting the provisions of Federal legislation for old-age assistance, declaring its effective date, and repealing all Acts and parts of Acts in conflict with any provision hereof" as approved April 2, 1937; the said sum so appropriated shall be covered by the Treasurer into the Old-Age Assistance Fund.

Section 3. All moneys in the Old-Age Assistance Fund shall be administered and disbursed in conformity with the provisions of said Act. Administered and disbursed, how.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

## CHAPTER 10.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 13]

To appropriate the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to defray expenses incurred by the Board of Public Welfare, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Treasury, not to exceed the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to defray the expenses of the Board of Public Welfare. Board of Public Welfare, Appropriation.

Section 2. All sums expended under the provisions of this Act shall be paid upon vouchers approved by the Board. How expended.
