### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the committees of the House and of the Senate on Judiciary and Federal Relations, at and during the present Session, be authorized to expend the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) each, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for required supplies and for the employment of additional clerical help.

The Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the above sums upon vouchers issued by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House.

### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the Thirteenth Regular Session of the Alaska Territorial Legislature convened at Juneau, Alaska, on the second Monday in January, 1937, as the law directs; and

WHEREAS, owing to the lack of transportation facilities caused by the long protracted marine strike, and unfavorable weather conditions such as to forbid travel by air, many members of the Legislature were not and could not be present for many days thereafter, thereby delaying much important legislation coming before this body; and

WHEREAS, the most important legislation ever to come before the Territorial Legislature, to-wit, the consideration, adoption,
