### SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED that the President of the Territorial Senate appoint a committee of three to wait upon the Governor of Alaska and ascertain if he had further communication to make to the Senate before adjournment.

Passed by the Senate, March 11, 1937.

### SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED by the Territorial Senate in its Thirteenth Biennial Session that it extends its sincere vote of thanks to John W. Troy, Governor of Alaska, and to all the other Territorial officials for their assistance rendered the Legislature during this session.

Passed by the Senate, March 11, 1937.

### SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 3

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in its Thirteenth Biennial Session assembled that a committee of three be appointed by the President to inform the House of Representatives that the Senate is now ready to adjourn.
