(c) Office of the Territorial Treasurer: Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for salaries, traveling expenses, clerical assistance, contingent office expense, and Territorial liquor stamps.

(d) Wolves and Coyotes: Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) for bounties.

Bounties for wolves and coyotes.

(e) Department of Public Welfare: Six Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-four and 46/100 Dollars (\$6,894.46) for office expenses, Seventy-two Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-two and 41/100 Dollars (\$72,492.41) for relief of destitution and needy and indigent.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT

[H. B. 12]

To appropriate Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00), or so much thereof as is necessary, and the balance not expended shall revert to the General Fund of the Territory, for "Transportation of Pupils", and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory, from funds not other-

wise appropriated, the sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00), or so much thereof as is necessary, and the balance not expended shall revert to the General Fund of the Territory, to be expended by the Board of Education of the Territory of Alaska, for Transportation of Pupils, and for no other purpose as provided under Sub-section (h) of Section 1289 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1933, for the biennium ending June 30, 1941, and to pay any deficiencies arising from the appropriation for said school transportation service during the biennium ending June 30, 1939.

How expended.

Sub-section (b). Provided that ten per cent of said sum must not be obligated on contracts but can be used to pay open-account current transportation costs during the biennium.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 13.

AN ACT

[S. B. 2]

In aid of the Federal Copyright Laws, to assist in effectuating their true intent and their enforcement in the Territory of Alaska by removing and declaring illegal certain monopolistic abuses and activities wrongfully practiced under the guise of copyrights within the Territory by price-fixing combinations, monopolies, and pools; to enforce the laws applicable to Alaska prohibiting price-fixing monopolies and combinations in restraint of commerce and trade; providing penalties for combining rights granted by the copyright laws where the effect of such combination results in the use of copyright privileges as instru-
