

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT

[S. B. 24]

To promote the use of Alaska's forest resources.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Alaska lumber
products to be
used exclusively.

Section 1. That in all projects, financed by Territorial public money, in which the use of timber, lumber, and manufactured lumber products is required, only such timber, lumber, and manufactured lumber products originating in Alaska from local forests shall be used, wherever practicable.

Calls for bid to
contain clause.

Section 2. A clause to this effect shall be inserted in all calls for bids and in all contracts awarded by the contracting officer.

CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT

[S. B. 21]

To establish the date of birth of residents of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Birth date
established by
law—how.

Section 1. Any resident of Alaska required by law to establish his or her date of birth, who is unable to furnish documentary proof of such fact may file a petition, verified with his or her oath, with the United States Commissioner of the precinct in which he or she resides, asking that the date of the birth of the petitioner be established as a matter of law.
