

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT

[H. B. 13]

To amend Chapter 67, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, by adding another section thereto and hereby restrict the payment of appropriations for travel of Territorial officials outside Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Chapter 67, Session Laws of Alaska, ^{Amended.} 1937, be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a section reading as follows:

“Section 2. Appropriations by the Territorial Legislature for traveling expense for the office of the Attorney General may be expended for per diem allowance ^{Territorial travel regulation.} or transportation outside the Territory for travel to and from attendance at Court, and that otherwise no appropriation made by the Territorial Legislature shall be expended for per diem or travel expense outside the Territory unless the Act of appropriation specifically provides therefor.”

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately after its ^{Emergency.} passage and approval.
