

CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT

[H. B. 84]

To appropriate Four Thousand Eight Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$4,008.70) to pay claims against the Territory of Alaska for hospitalization and medical services, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Four Thousand Eight Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$4,008.70) is hereby appropriated, Appropriation to pay claims for hospitalization. out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to cover claims submitted against the Territory as follows:

Seward General Hospital, Seward\$2,227.50

Maynard Columbus Hospital, Nome 1,781.20

Payment under this appropriation may be made upon How paid. vouchers properly itemized, and approved by the Director of Public Welfare for the Territory of Alaska, such amount as shall be deemed proper, and no such voucher shall include any claim for expense incurred subsequent to December 31, 1938.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist Emergency. and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
