

CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT

[H. B. 117]

To amend Chapter 71, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, by adding thereto another Section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

Section 1. That Chapter 71, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, is hereby amended by adding thereto another Section to read as follows:

Vacancies on
Public Utility
District Boards.

“Section 18. Vacancies. In the event any member of the Board of Directors shall depart from the District with intent of remaining absent more than ninety days, or shall have failed to attend the meetings of the Board for a period of ninety consecutive days, or shall have attended less than five of the meetings of the Board during any continuous period of five months, the Board may declare the office of such member vacant. A vacancy may also be created by the resignation of a member presented in writing and duly accepted by the Board, or by the death of a member or his removal from office by the court or, if he shall fail after his election to qualify within thirty days after such election.

Vacancies
filled—How.

“Whenever a vacancy occurs the remaining members may elect some qualified person to fill such vacancy and the person so elected shall hold office until a successor be elected at the next ensuing annual election and duly qualified.”
