

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT

[H. B. 35]

To amend Sections 1189, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to marriage licenses, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1189, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: Amended.

“Section 1189. License required and facts to be shown before license issues. No person shall be joined in marriage until a license shall have been obtained for that purpose from a United States Commissioner. No marriage license shall be issued unless both of the contracting parties shall be identified to the satisfaction of the proper commissioner, who shall further require a statement under oath, relative to the legality of the contemplated marriage, the names, relationship, if any, nationality, color, residence and occupation of parties, guardians of such, if under the age of legal majority, and prior marriage or marriages of the parties, or either of them, and manner of the dissolution thereof, and if there be no legal objection thereto such commissioner shall issue a license in the form hereinafter provided. The statement under oath in this section required may be made and executed before a Notary Public who shall certify the same to the Commissioner of the precinct in which the statement is made and certified. Marriage license required and facts to be shown before issuance thereof.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.
