

CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT

[S. B. 5]

For the return of over-payment of Gross License Taxes to Grace Lowe, of Livengood, Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Forty-seven Dollars and Eighty-two Cents (\$147.82) is hereby appropriated out of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the benefit of Grace Lowe, of Livengood, Alaska, as a refund for Gross License Taxes paid by the said Grace Lowe in excess of the required amount of taxes due and owing under Territorial Provisional License No. 37-000, and the Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay said sum to the said Grace Lowe.

CHAPTER 4.

AN ACT

[S. B. 9]

To amend Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Chapter 36, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, relating to the construction and equipment of a hospital at Seldovia, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Chapter 36 Amended. of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, be, and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

Appropriation
for Seldovia
Hospital.

“Section 1. That the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Territory of Alaska to assist in the construction and equipment of a hospital at Seldovia, Alaska.”

Available and
to be utilized
—when.

“Section 2. That the appropriation hereby made shall become available immediately upon the passage and approval of this Act, and that said appropriation shall be utilized for constructing and equipping the same during the biennium ending March 31, 1941.”

Management of.

“Section 3. That the management and control of the said hospital shall be in the hands of the Board of Directors of Seldovia Public Utilities, an incorporated Public Utility District; and said management shall be supervised by the Commissioner of Health of the Territory of Alaska.”

How paid.

“Section 4. That vouchers covering expenditures under the provisions of this Act shall be approved by the said Board of Directors and the Commissioner of Health, and submitted to the Auditor of Alaska for settlement and payment.”

Emergency.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
