

CHAPTER 40.

AN ACT

[H. B. 27]

To appropriate the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to assist the Town of Haines, Alaska in the construction or alterations and additions to a School Building, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the Treasury of the Territory not otherwise appropriated to assist the Town of Haines, Alaska in the construction or alterations and addition to a School Building.

Section 2. The said sum shall be expended under the supervision of the Common Council of said Town of Haines and shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Commissioner of Education.

How paid.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT

[H. B. 1]

To provide for bounties on wolves and coyotes and the manner of paying such bounties, and repealing certain laws now in effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Bounty on Wolves or Coyotes. There is hereby placed upon every wild lobo or timber wolf and
