

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT

[H. B. 114]

To appropriate the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, to assist in equipping and operating the Griffin Memorial Hospital at Kodiak, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars, (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, be, and the same hereby is, appropriated, and made available and payable out of the road funds appropriated and allotted to the Third Division of the Territory of Alaska, for the biennium ending March 31, 1941, to assist in equipping and operating the Griffin Memorial Hospital at Kodiak, Alaska.

Section 2. Vouchers covering the expenditures under the provision of this Act shall be approved by the Board of Trustees of the Griffin Memorial Hospital and the Territorial Highway Engineer.

How paid

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
