

CHAPTER 59.

AN ACT

[H. B. 120]

To amend Sections 2, 3, 4, and 5, Chapter 68, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, relating to cosmetology.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Chapter 68, Session ^{Amended.} Laws of Alaska, 1935, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 2. There is hereby created the Board of Cosmetology to consist of a chairman, who shall be the ^{Board of} Commissioner of Health of the Territory of Alaska; ^{Cosmetology} a ^{created.} secretary, who shall be a graduate cosmetologist appointed by the Governor for a term of four years, and four graduate cosmetologists to be appointed by the Governor, one from each Judicial Division of the Territory, to serve without pay for terms of one, two, three and four years respectively, the appointments to be made upon the expiration of the terms of the present Board members.”

Section 2. That Section 3 of Chapter 68, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, be, and the same is hereby ^{Amended.} amended to read as follows:

“Section 3. It shall be the duty of the said Board to ^{Duty of Board.} prescribe reasonable rules and regulations governing the practice of hairdressing and cosmetology only in the Territory, issue certificates and in general to regulate the practice of the said profession. A copy of all rules and regulations adopted shall be furnished to each person, firm or corporation to whom a certificate of registration and license is issued.

“The Board may conduct examinations for licenses, and an examination may be held by each of the Board members in each of their respective Divisions with the

consent and approval of the entire Board. Any applicant for license by examination under this Act shall be not less than eighteen years of age, of good moral character and temperate habits, be able to read and write the English language intelligently, and who has completed a course of training of not less than six months in a licensed school of cosmetology and who holds a diploma therefrom or who, by training, is qualified to practice cosmetology. Applicants for license under this Act who have been examined and licensed by any State Board of cosmetology may be granted a license without examination, upon proof that they hold a license from any of the States in force at the time of making application, and upon payment of the fee required in Section 5 of this Act. Shop owners may be licensed without examination, but unless qualified under this Act shall not engage in the practice of hairdressing or cosmetology.

Records kept.

“The Board shall keep a record of the registration, containing the name and known places of business, and the date and number of license, of every licensed hairdresser and cosmetical, together with the names and addresses of all cosmetological establishments, registered under this Act.

“It shall be a duty of the Board to keep accurate records of all monies derived from the payment of license fees as required under this Act. All monies so derived shall be paid into the general fund of the Territory.”

Amended.

Section 3. That Section 4 of Chapter 68, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Effective date.

“Section 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1st, 1935, and the first licenses shall be issued for the year beginning July 1st, 1935, and ending June 30, 1936. Any person who has been conducting an establishment for the practice of cosmetology for one year immediately

prior to January 1, 1935, and any employee of such establishment who has been continuously employed for one year prior to that date within the Territory, shall be issued a license upon making application on or before July 1, 1935 and tendering the fee required in Section 5 of this Act."

Section 4. That Section 5 of Chapter 68, Session ^{Amended.} Laws of Alaska, 1935, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. The following is a schedule of fees to ^{Registration and license fees.} be paid said board under the provisions of this Act:

"Registration and initial license fee for owners or managers, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00); renewal yearly, Five Dollars (\$5.00).

"Registration and initial license fee for operators, Five Dollars (\$5.00); renewal yearly, Two Dollars (\$2.00).

"Every person who has heretofore been granted, or shall hereafter be granted, a license to practice the occupation of cosmetician or hairdresser in any beauty shop or hair dressing establishment within the Territory, shall on or before the 30th day of June each year pay an annual license fee for the year commencing with the first day of July next following, and upon the payment of such renewal fee the Secretary of the board shall issue to such licentiate a renewal certificate; provided, that if renewal fee is not paid by July 1 of each year a penalty of One Dollar (\$1.00) shall be added to such renewal fee."
