

## Saving Clauses.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Act shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Act as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

## Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 6.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 25]

To reimburse Library Associations for expenditures made during the biennium ending March 31, 1937, making appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Appropriation  
for Library  
association.

Section 1. That Eight Hundred Four Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents (\$804.26) be appropriated out of the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, of monies not otherwise appropriated, to pay balances due the following Library Associations, for the biennium ending March 31, 1937, as provided by Section 1, Chapter 82, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, and not heretofore paid:

Sitka Library Association .....	\$ 82.47
George C. Thomas Memorial Li- brary, Fairbanks .....	150.00
Hyder Public Library .....	15.93
Haines Woman's Club .....	35.79

Skagway Public Library .....	150.00
Petersburg Public Library .....	150.00

Valdez Library .....	74.70

Section 2. The sums above stated shall be paid upon <sup>How paid.</sup> vouchers approved by the Governor of Alaska.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist <sup>Emergency.</sup> and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 7.

AN ACT

[H. B. 28]

For the return of Restaurant Liquor License Tax on an unused License to Shirley George of Sitka, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) is hereby appropriated from the Gen-<sup>Appropriation</sup>eral Fund of the Territory of Alaska for the benefit of <sup>for Shirley</sup>Shirley George of Sitka as a refund for Territorial <sup>George—Tax</sup>Liquor Tax paid by said Shirley George for License <sup>refund.</sup>number 1399 on May 17, 1938, which said license was never used for reasons beyond the control of said Shirley George, and the Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay said sum to the said Shirley George.
