

## CHAPTER 64.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 891]

To provide for the interchange of Territorial employees.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Territorial  
employees may  
be interchanged.

Section 1. The head of any executive or administrative department of the Territory may, with the consent of the head of another executive or administrative department, temporarily secure the services of employees of such other department, and any employee temporarily assigned to duty in another department shall be subject to the direction of the head of the department assigned to.

Compensation.

Section 2. The compensation of any employee so assigned shall not be affected by reason thereof.

## CHAPTER 65.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 921]

To appropriate the sum of \$375.00 to pay claims for professional services rendered in preparing preliminary plans and estimates and other work in assisting the Legislature's Pioneer Home Committee and the Building Committee in connection with the erection of the Alaska Pioneers' Home at Sitka, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Appropriation  
for N. Lester  
Troast.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$375.00 out of the funds of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, to compensate professional

services rendered in furnishing preliminary plans, estimates and other work, with the Pioneer Home Committee of the Legislature, and including traveling expenses and conference in connection with the erection of the Alaska Pioneer Home, at Sitka, Alaska, said services rendered being requested by the Governor and the Pioneer Home Committee; and said appropriation to be paid on vouchers approved by the Governor to the following person in the amount stated, to wit:

N. Lester Troast & Associates .....\$375.00

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist<sup>Emergency.</sup> and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 66.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 54]

To amend Chapter 22, Session Laws of 1937, by adding thereto eight additional sections, numbered 45 to 52, both inclusive; to amend the title thereof by adding thereto and including therein the title of this Act; to provide for the effecting of insurance with resident and non-resident associations and the licensing of non-resident agents and brokers; to authorize non-licensed associations to effect insurance in the Territory under certain conditions; to provide for the qualification of agents and brokers effecting such insurance; to provide for annual statements and premium tax; to regulate the writing and effecting of insurance; to prohibit the placing of insurance with impaired or insolvent associations, to provide for the service of process upon associations, and to provide penalties for violations, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Chapter 22, Session Laws of 1937,<sup>Amended.</sup> be hereby amended by adding thereto eight additional
