CHAPTER 7.

AN ACT

[H. B. 28]

For the return of Restaurant Liquor License Tax on an unused License to Shirley George of Sitka, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) is hereby appropriated from the Gen-^{Appropriation}eral Fund of the Territory of Alaska for the benefit of ^{for Shirley}Shirley George of Sitka as a refund for Territorial ^{George—Tax}Liquor Tax paid by said Shirley George for License ^{refund.}number 1399 on May 17, 1938, which said license was never used for reasons beyond the control of said Shirley George, and the Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay said sum to the said Shirley George.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT

[S. B. 11]

To appropriate the sum of \$5,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary for preliminary proceedings connected with the construction of the International Highway.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for Donald
MacDonald.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$5,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay a reasonable compensation to and the reasonable expenses incurred and to be incurred by Donald MacDonald, of Fairbanks, Alaska, in the discharge of his duties as a member of the Alaskan International Highway Commission.

How paid.

Section 2. The amount herein appropriated shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Highway Engineer.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
