"Each Marriage Commissioner appointed under the provisions of this Act shall require the applicant for a marriage license to execute an application in duplicate, the original of which he shall retain in the files of his office, and the duplicate he shall forward to the United States Commissioner as provided by Section 1214, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933."

Amended.

Section 3. That Section 1214, Article V, Chapter XIV, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Return of license
and marriage—
when.

"Section 1214. Return of license and marriage. Within seventy-five days after the solemnization of any marriage, the marriage commissioner shall forward to the United States Commissioner within whose precinct the ceremony is performed, the marriage license issued and if the ceremony is performed by him a copy of the marriage certificate issued, together with the executed application for the marriage certificate."

CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT

[H. B. 33]

To set apart \$25,000.00, out of the road fund to be apportioned to the First Division for the biennium 1939-1941 to assist the Towns of Douglas and Skagway in the completion, alteration and equipment of school buildings and gymnasias, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for Douglas School
Gymnasium.

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) is hereby appropriated and made available

and payable from road funds that shall be allotted to the First Division out of the appropriation provided by Chapter 19, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, to assist the Town of Douglas, Alaska in the construction of a gymnasium-auditorium, an addition to the Douglas School Building. That the sum of \$10,000.00, or as much thereof as is necessary, is hereby appropriated to assist the town of Skagway, Alaska, in the completion and equipping of its school building and the construction of a gymnasium, the said \$10,000.00 to be set apart from the road fund set apart for the First Division for the biennium 1939-1941.

Section 2. The said sums shall be expended under the ^{How paid.} supervision of the Common Councils of said Towns of Douglas and Skagway and shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Commissioner of Education.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist ^{Emergency.} and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT

[S. B. 561]

Declaring a policy of cooperation with the Federal Government in flood control and river and harbor improvement projects and defining the liability of the Territory thereunder and for other purposes, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the public policy of this Territory is declared to be one of cooperation with the Federal ^{Territorial policy on flood control and river and harbor improvements.}
