

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT

[H. B. 51]

To provide for a referendum on Territorial control of intoxicating beverages by establishment of Territorial liquor stores

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the electors of the Territory of Alaska at the next General Election to be holden in 1940 for the purpose of electing a Delegate to Congress, Members of the Legislature and other Territorial officers, the question of whether the voters are or are not in favor of the establishment of Territorial liquor stores to have control of the sale of all kinds of intoxicating alcoholic beverages.

Section 2. There shall be given to every voter separate ballot reading substantially as follows:

REFERENDUM BALLOT

Territorial control of intoxicating beverages by the establishment of Territorial liquor stores.

In favor of Territorial control place "X" opposite "For".

Against Territorial control place "X" opposite "Against".

VOTE FOR ONE

FOR

AGAINST

The ballots for each Division shall be printed so that on half thereof the word "For" and its corresponding bracket or box will be first, and that on half thereof the word "Against" and its corresponding bracket or box will be first, and substantially the same number of each form of such ballots shall be distributed to a voting precinct.

Canvass of
returns.

Section 3. The canvass of the returns of the will of said citizens so expressed shall be in the same manner as is prescribed for the canvassing of the returns of the election of a Delegate to Congress, members of the Legislature and other Territorial officers, and the result thereof shall be certified and transmitted by the Governor to the next succeeding Legislature on the first day of the convening thereof, or as soon thereafter as convenient.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT

[H. B. 100]

To amend Section 2702, Chapter XLVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 16, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, relating to annual and sick leave of Territorial employees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

Section 1. That the first paragraph of Section 2702, Chapter XLVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 16, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, be amended to read as follows:

Annual sick
leave for
Territorial
employees.

"Sec. 2702. Annual and Sick Leave. The head of any Territorial office may grant thirty working days annual leave of absence with pay in any one year to each clerk or employee of such Territorial office, and
