

## CHAPTER 89.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 76]

To appropriate funds for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska, for the biennium beginning April 1, 1939 and ending March 31, 1941, and for the school years commencing July 1, 1939 and ending June 30, 1940 and commencing July 1, 1940 and ending June 31, 1941, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Three Million Five Hundred <sup>Appropriation</sup>Eleven Thousand Five Hundred Ten Dollars (\$3,511, <sup>for biennium</sup>510.00) or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is <sup>ending March</sup>hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the Territory for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1939 and ending March 31, 1940 and for the fiscal year commencing April 1, 1940 and ending March 31, 1941, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:
