

House Joint Resolutions

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the Governor of Alaska be, and he hereby is, authorized to employ, for such number of hours per day and for such compensation as shall to him seem necessary and reasonable, a janitor and charwoman to clean, care for and keep in proper order the rooms occupied by the Legislature; and that the expenses necessarily incurred therefore, not in any event to exceed **Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00)** shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the Governor.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, in Fourteenth Regular Session assembled, having knowledge of the important part played by the late Edward W. Griffin, Secretary of Alaska, in initiating and carrying to completion the Kodiak General Hospital project; and,

That, but for the untiring perseverance of this unselfish and loyal-hearted humanitarian, whose name will always stand as a synonym for everything genuinely Alaskan, the accomplishment of this work would have been impossible;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Fourteenth Regular Session of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska that, in recognition of his

humane principles and unselfish efforts and to perpetuate his achievements in the memory of his fellow Alaskans, the Kodiak General Hospital shall be known as the "Griffin Memorial Hospital"; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the construction of said hospital there shall be inscribed thereon in a prominent and appropriate place the words, "Griffin Memorial Hospital", and such shall be done under the supervision, and with the approval of the Territorial Highway Engineer.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the Committees of the House and of the Senate on Permanent Help be, and they are hereby authorized to expend the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) each, or so much thereof as is necessary, for payment of overtime to the office and clerical employees of the Fourteenth Session.

The Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the above sum upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House.
