

CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT

[S. B. 19]

For the partial refund of beverage dispensary license fee for 1940 to George Gilbertson of Fairbanks, Alaska, and making an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Liquor license
refund.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of funds in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for and the Territorial Treasurer is authorized to pay to George Gilbertson of Fairbanks, Alaska, upon a voucher signed by the latter, the sum of \$482.20 as a partial refund of the license fee of \$500 paid for Territorial Beverage Dispensary License No. 4335 issued in 1940 and to be used in a place of business two miles South of Fairbanks, Alaska.

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT

[H. B. 61]

Appropriating One Hundred Twenty (\$120.00) Dollars to reimburse Lyle Airways for emergency flights, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Reimbursing
Lyle Airways.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of One Hundred Twenty (\$120.00) Dollars not otherwise

appropriated, to reimburse Lyle Airways for services rendered by emergency flights from Gakona to McCarthy and McCarthy to Cordova, Alaska, in connection with and the transportation of Jack Bishop, a seriously injured indigent, to a hospital.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in force immediately after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT

[H. B. 43]

To amend Section 2143 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to any employer's failure to pay, and providing further penalties for infraction of the provisions thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2143 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2143. Failure to pay; punishment. Any employer who, having the means so to do, shall wilfully or fraudulently, with intent to annoy, harass, oppress or defraud any employee, or any employer who shall have misrepresented to an employee or employees his ability to pay,

Failure to pay
wages—Penalty.
