

and shall refuse to pay such employee upon demand the money due him as herein provided, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment in a Federal jail for a period not exceeding six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT

[S. B. 30]

To amend Section 9, Chapter 78 of the Session Laws, 1937.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 9, Chapter 78, Sub-section (A) of the Session Laws, 1937, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 9. Local Option.

(A) Whenever thirty-five per cent (35%) of the total number of voters at the last general municipal election held in any incorporated city or town shall petition the Court so to do, the Court shall cause to be placed upon a separate ballot at the next municipal election in such incorporated city or town the following question: “For the sale of intoxicating liquors” (yes or no). It shall be the duty of the regular election

vote on.

officers to canvass the said ballots and to report the results thereof to the Clerk of the District Court. If, upon receipt of the certificate of election, the Clerk of the District Court finds that a majority of the voters are against the sale of intoxicating liquor in said incorporated city or town, all applications for licenses within the said city or town shall thereafter be denied and no further licenses shall be issued therein for a period of one year, and until the voters therein, at a subsequent election held in the manner herein provided for, shall decide that licenses may be issued."

CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT

[H. B. 49]

To appropriate the sum of \$8,000.00 to assist the Town of Valdez in equipping its hospital; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$8,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated to assist the Town of Valdez in the purchase of needed hospital equipment.

Section 2. Said sum shall be expended by the Directors of the Valdez Community Hospital Association under the supervision and direction of the Commissioner of Health and shall be paid by the Treasurer upon vouchers approved by said Commissioner.
