Section 3. None of the funds herein provided shall be expended until it shall have been made to appear to the satisfaction of the said Commissioner of Health that a building suitable for the hospitalization of patients is available in said town of Valdez and that the same can and will be maintained without any cost or expense to the Territory.

Section 4. The Directors of said Community Hospital Association shall prepare and file with the Commissioner of Health a detailed inventory of all equipment purchased under the provisions of this Act and the whole thereof shall be delivered to said Commissioner or such other officer as the Legislature may hereafter designate, whenever the said Hospital shall cease to function as such.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall become effective upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT

[H. B. 13]

To appropriate the sum of \$5,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary for preliminary proceedings connected with the construction of the International Highway, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$5,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay

a reasonable compensation to and the reasonable expenses incurred and to be incurred by Donald MacDonald, of Fairbanks, Alaska, in the discharge of his duties as a member of the Alaska International Highway Commission.

Section 2. The amount herein appropriated shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 22.

AN ACT

[H. B. 11]

To provide for the regulation, bonding, supervision and licensing of collection agencies; to provide penalties and to repeal Chapter 55, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation not being an attorney at law duly authorized to practice in the Territory of Alaska, or a national or Territorial bank, shall conduct a collection agency, collection bureau or collection office or engage in the Territory directly or
