

CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT

[H. B. 29]

To amend Section 5643, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to coroners' inquests.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 5643, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5643. To summon jury to hold inquest. In such case he must go to the place where the dead person is, or, in the alternative, arrange for a United States Marshal, or his duly appointed deputy to do so, such officer shall be required to report his findings to said Commissioner, on the basis of which said Commissioner may proceed with an inquest or not, as the case warrants, provided that if an inquest is warranted, said Commissioner shall forthwith summon six persons qualified by law to serve as jurors, to appear before him forthwith at a specified place, to inquire into the cause of the death."

Coroner's inquest; Commissioner or Marshal to investigate; when inquest to be held.

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT

[H. B. 74]

To amend Section 1 of Chapter 77, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, pertaining to Assay Offices in the Territory of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 77, Session Laws

of Alaska, 1937, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of aiding bona fide miners and prospectors and stimulating mineral discoveries, the Commissioner of Mines is empowered and directed to establish public assay offices in the Territory of Alaska, to be located at Ketchikan, Alaska, College, Alaska, Nome, Alaska, and Anchorage, Alaska.

CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT

[S. B. 531]

To amend Chapter 76 of the Session Laws of Alaska for 1937, relative to the Fisheries Experimental Commission, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 76 of the Session Laws of Alaska for 1937 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 3. Fisheries Experimental Commission Established.

There is hereby established a Fisheries Experimental Commission, hereinafter referred to as the ‘Commission,’ consisting of the Governor of Alaska, the Fisheries Technologist in charge of the Ketchikan Fisheries Experimental Lab-
