

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT

[S. B. 42]

To amend Section 4781, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, providing punishment for kidnaping.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That section 4781, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 4781. Kidnaping. Every person who, without lawful authority, forcefully seizes and confines another or inveigles or kidnaps another, with intent either—

Crimes; Criminal Offenses;—Kidnaping, defined, amending Sec. 4781, C.L.A., '33.

First. To cause such other person to be secretly confined or imprisoned in said Territory against his will; or

Second. To cause such other person to be sent out of said Territory against his will, or to be sent or transported from one place in this Territory to another place therein, against his will, shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary not less than one nor more than ten years.”
