

provided herein with respect to the administration of this Act as he deems necessary or appropriate to facilitate the administration of any such unemployment compensation or public employment service law, and in like manner, to accept and utilize information, services and facilities made available to this Territory by the agency charged with the administration of any such other unemployment compensation or public employment service law.

Section 34. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT

[S. B. 271]

To amend Section 1375 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1375, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Schools:
elementary and
high schools
defined.

“Section 1375. Elementary and high schools; definition. Elementary schools shall mean schools offering work from kindergarten to eighth grade inclusive. A kindergarten shall not be considered an essential part of

an elementary school. High schools shall mean schools offering work in grade nine to fourteen, inclusive; provided that the thirteenth and fourteenth years of high school shall be restricted to courses in vocational training and, may be offered only in city schools and in schools in incorporated school districts; provided further that junior high schools offering work in grades seven to nine or seven to ten, inclusive, and senior high schools offering work in grades ten to twelve or eleven to fourteen, inclusive, may be organized in the discretion of the city school boards. Nothing in this section shall prevent a high school from issuing a diploma after completion of the twelfth grade."

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT

[S. B. 91]

To amend Section 941 and 1016, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, by adding a paragraph to each thereof, and relating to corporations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 941, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 89, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, is hereby amended by adding an additional paragraph at the end of said section to read as follows:

Business Corporations, Foreign—amendment to articles of incorporation, filing with Clerks of Court and Auditor, penalty.
